- “**Dead Poets Society**” (1989) - **Transformational leadership** Teacher inspires his students to pursue their passions and think independently.
- “**The Green Mile**” (1999) Main character actions reflect **servant leadership** as he prioritizes the humane treatment and dignity of the inmates.
- “**The Devil Wears Prada**” (2006) Miranda Priestly exemplifies **autocratic leadership**, making decisions unilaterally with little input from her staff.
- “**Apollo 13**” (1995) The mission control team and astronauts demonstrate **democratic leadership**, valuing the input and expertise of all team members.
- “**The Pursuit of Happyness**” (2006) Shows the power of positive attitude and resilience in leadership (**positive leadership**).
