• "The Devil Wears Prada" (2006) Miranda Priestly exemplifies *autocratic leadership*, making decisions unilaterally with little input from her staff.

• "Apollo 13" (1995) The mission control team and astronauts demonstrate *democratic*. *leadership*, valuing the input and expertise of all team members.

• **"The Pursuit of Happyness" (2006)** Shows the power of positive attitude and resilience in leadership (*positive leadership*).
